



KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST 2023-2024

Parents are responsible to supply the following: (Please label all items)

- School bag/backpack - large enough to hold folder, library books, lunch kit and snow pants, hat and mittens in winter. (at least 32x32 cm but no wider than 42 cm please)
** your child will be responsible for packing this bag themselves so please make sure they can put everything inside it and zip it up independently.
- Indoor runners (each shoe labeled, these are necessary to participate in gym)
 - Please no runners with laces unless your child is capable of tying their own and **MUST** be runners with backs
- Water bottle (NO-SPILL)
- Headphones (in a Ziploc bag) – No ear buds if possible
- 2 large boxes of Kleenex (unlabeled)
- 1 box of large Ziploc bags (a box of 10-20 is good)
- Ziploc bag with extra clothing – please include a change of shirt, pants, socks, underwear (all labelled)
 - This bag will be kept in the classroom in case of emergencies during the school year.
- 8 Photos of your child
 - 2 copies of a Wall of Fame photo (4x6 candid shot)
 - 2 copies of a family photo
 - Child with friend photo
 - Summer activity photo
 - House photo – child in front of his/her house (photo should include the whole house)
