School Supply List for Grade Three 2023-2024

Grade 3 families are responsible to supply the following:

- 1 school bag: needs to be backpack style and large enough for a lunch kit and school
- 1 lunch bag: re-useable containers at lunch times are recommended whenever possible to help reduce waste
- 1 pair indoor running shoes: running shoes that are easy to put on and take off independently. Velcro ONLY for students who are not yet able to tie their own shoes independently. PLEASE - NO DECK SHOES, CANVAS SHOES OR "FASHION" RUNNERS.
- 1 leak proof plastic water bottle: one with a pop-up sip spout instead of a wide mouth opening because it is less likely to spill when accidentally tipped over.
- 1 set headphones: Please put headphones in a large, labeled Ziploc bag (3/8" or 3.5 mm jack).
- 1 large box of Kleenex
